

# Release Agreement

Between United Cooperative Services & Licensed Electrician

## I. Description of work to be performed:

- A.** This Agreement between United Cooperative Services (hereinafter referred to as UCS) and the below mentioned Licensed Electrician, shall be for the sole purpose of convenience to UCS's customer and shall include the act of removing the meter or cutting loose of secondary wire at the weatherhead, **within 2" of the existing splice**, belonging to the customer of UCS. This action is to be only disconnection and not permanent reconnection of the service wire belonging to UCS.
- B.** Under this agreement the Licensed Electrician shall, **before** any such disconnection shall occur, **contact UCS and supply the meter number, name and address of the customer** location where the work is to be performed. **After the work is complete**, the Electrician will **contact UCS** to re-seal the meter or make permanent connections to the service wire.

## II. Protection of Persons and Property

- A.** The Licensed Electrician shall at all times take all reasonable precautions for the safety of employees on the work site and of the public, and shall comply with all applicable provisions of Federal, State, and Municipal Safety Laws and building construction codes, as well as the safety rules and regulations of UCS\*.
- 1.** **\*Rubber gloves** with appropriate protectors shall be worn when installing or removing meters and disconnecting service conductor. Rubber glove protectors should not be used as normal work gloves. **Safety glasses** and **appropriate clothing** shall also be worn anytime there is a possibility of an electric flash. **Refer to OSHA standard 29 CFR 1910.269.**
- B.** The Licensed Electrician shall do all things necessary or expedient to protect UCS's property and property of others from damage in the course of performing any action needed to disconnect or cut loose Customer's service, and at its own expense, restore any or all such damaged property immediately to as good a state as before such damage occurred.
- C.** To the maximum extent permitted by Law, The Licensed Electrician shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless UCS and UCS's directors, Officers, and Employees from all claims, causes of action, losses, liabilities, and expenses, (including reasonable attorney's fees) for personal loss, injury, or death to persons (including but not limited to Licensed Electrician's employees) and loss, damage to or destruction of Owner's property or the property of any other person or entity (including but not limited to Electrician's property) in any manner arising out of or connected with the Action, or the materials or equipment supplied or services performed by the Licensed Electrician, its Subcontractors and suppliers of any Tier. Licensed Electrician shall promptly discharge or remove any such Lien or claim by bonding, payment, or otherwise and shall notify UCS promptly when it has done so. If Electrician does not cause such Lien or claim to be released by payment, bonding, or otherwise, UCS shall have the right (but is not obligated) to pay all sums necessary to obtain any such discharge or release and to Invoice all amounts so paid and to expect and receive payment for such charges within thirty days. But nothing herein shall be construed as making Licensed Electrician liable for any injury, death, loss, damage, or destruction caused by the sole negligence of UCS or its employees.
