**Construction Allowances – Updated January 2017 (Effective February 8, 2017)**

**Permanent Residential Service Construction Allowance (no existing transformer) = \$4,400**

The allowance is designed to offset the cost of the installation of 150 feet of underground service in a rock ditch, and a pole mounted transformer that is designed to serve a 200 amp service.

**Permanent Residential Service Construction Allowance (existing transformer) = \$2,900**

The allowance is designed to offset the cost of the installation of 150 feet of underground service in a rock ditch that is designed to serve a 200 amp service.

**Auxiliary Residential Service Construction Allowance = \$800**

The allowance is designed to offset the cost of the installation of approximately 75 feet of overhead service that is designed to serve a 100 amp service from an existing transformer.

**Permanent Residential Development Lot Allowance = \$4,400**

The allowance is designed to offset the cost of the installation of 150 feet of underground service in a rock ditch, and a pole mounted transformer that is designed to serve a 200 amp service.

**Area Light Installation Allowance = \$1,150**

This allowance is designed to offset the installed cost of a 50w LED light fixture, a standard wooden utility pole, and 100' of overhead service conductor to energize the light from an existing transformer.

**Street Light Installation Allowance = \$1,250**

This allowance is designed to offset the cost of the materials (only) required to install a standard steel and/or aluminum street light fixture and pole, and 150' of underground service conductor to energize the light.
